## **Nationwide Crime Analysis Mid-Year 2025 vs 2024**

Preliminary figures for the mid-year 2025 indicate that major crimes decreased by 14% with 1,223 cases, compared to 1,420 over the same period in 2024. There were regional decreases across the board in New Providence, Grand Bahama and the Northern Bahamas and the Family Islands District at rates of 15%, 11% and 6% respectively.

Crimes against the person decreased by 30% with 262 incidents, compared to 373 over the same period in 2024. There were regional decreases in crimes against the person across the board at rates of 31% in New Providence, 23% in Grand Bahama and 25% in the Family Islands District. Crimes against the property decreased by 8%, with 961 incidents, compared to 1,047 over the same period in 2024. There were regional decreases at rates of 9% in New Providence, 7% in Grand Bahama and 1% in the Family Islands District.

**Homicides** decreased by 27% with 44 incidents, compared to 60 in 2024. There were 39 murders in New Providence, 3 in the Family Islands and 2 in the Grand Bahama District. The overall solvency rate stands at 64%. Victims between the ages of 18 and 45 represent 84% of all homicides. Retaliation, gang and conflict were the most common motives for murder, representing 64% collectively. Based on preliminary figures, homicides were more likely to occur on a Sunday than any other day of the week. Homicides were more prevalent in the **Southern** and **South Central Divisions**, accounting for 41% of the overall total. Firearms were used in the commission of 34 homicides and fatal gunshot wounds remain the leading cause of death in these matters.

**Armed Robberies** decreased by 42% with 76 incidents, compared to 132 over the same period in 2024. Armed robberies were more prevalent in the **Southwestern**, **South Central**, and **Southeastern Divisions**, accounting for 53% of the overall total. Based on preliminary figures, armed robberies were more likely to occur on a Sunday and Monday than any other day of the week and these incidents peak between the hours of 4pm and 11pm. Most armed robberies occurred at the street level, businesses and at residences respectively. Firearms continue to be the weapon of choice for the commission of armed robberies. Notably, there were 29 vehicles taken in the commission of these incidents. Thirty-four percent of vehicles taken during armed robberies were recovered. Males represent the highest percentage of victims of armed robbery at 64%, compared to female victims at 36%.

**Stolen vehicles** increased by 30% with 236 incidents, compared to 181 over the same period in 2024. Nissan make vehicles were the most targeted, representing 83% of all vehicles stolen. The Nissan Cube and Note were the predominant models stolen, while residences were the most targeted locations. Stolen vehicles were mostly reported in the **Southwestern** and **Southeastern Divisions**, accounting for 49% of the overall total. Fifty-six percent of all stolen vehicles were recovered.

**Stealing from vehicles** decreased by 4% with 92 incidents, compared to 96 over the same period in 2024. The most frequent items stolen included cash, cellular phones, and personal effects. Nissan March and Honda Accords were mostly targeted in the commission of these offences. Based on preliminary figures, stealing from vehicles were more likely to occur on a Tuesday than

any other day of the week. Stealing from vehicles were mostly reported in the **Southwestern, South Central and Southeastern Divisions**, accounting for 40% of recorded cases.

**Housebreakings** decreased by 39% with 87 incidents, compared to 142 over the same period in 2024. The **New Providence District** accounted for 46% of all housebreakings. **Grand Bahama**, including **Abaco and Bimini**, accounted for 18 or 21% of housebreakings. The **Family Islands District** accounted for 29 or 33% of housebreakings, most of which occurred in **Eleuthera** with 16 incidents.

**Shopbreakings** decreased by 16% with 140 incidents, compared to 166 over the same period in 2024. The **New Providence District** accounted for 93 or 66% of all shopbreakings. **Grand Bahama**, including **Abaco and Bimini**, accounted for 25 or 18% of shopbreakings, most of which occurred in the **Abaco Division** with 12 incidents. The **Family Islands District** accounted for 22 or 16%, most of which occurred in **Eleuthera** with 14 incidents. Based on preliminary figures, shopbreakings were more likely to occur on a Friday than any other day of the week.

For the period in review, a total of 196 **firearms** and 8,369 rounds of ammunition were discovered and/or seized throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result, 208 persons were arrested and 143 persons were charged with illegal firearms and ammunition offences. **ShotSpotter Technology** detected 488 gunshot incidents, consisting of 259 multiple shots, 170 single shots and 59 probable shots, totaling 1,004 rounds discharged.

Notably, the officers of the Royal Bahamas Police Force conducted 11,306 field check patrols, 74,019 stop and search profiles, 3,057 road checks, 2,378 warrants of arrest and 1,680 search warrants throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result of these efforts, 8,388 persons were arrested for various major and minor offences. Of this number, 5,127 persons were charged and placed before the Court, representing a 61% charge rate. There were 2,268 court returns which included 1,572 convictions, 7 cases were discharged due to the defendant's death, 79 cases were acquitted at the end of trial, 390 cases were discharged by the court and 220 cases were withdrawn by the virtual complainant.




For the period in review, murder decreased by 27% with 44 incidents, compared to 60 over the same period in 2024













## Sexual Offences





## Armed Robbery

For the period in review, armed robberies decreased by 42% with 76 incidents, compared to 132 over the same period in 2024.




### Armed Robbery - Police Divisions






### Armed Robbery - Weapon Type






### Armed Robbery Victim Age Demographics





### Armed Robbery Suspect Age Demographics




For the period in review, housebreakings decreased by 39% with 87 incidents, compared to 142 in 2024.








## Stolen Vehicles


Stolen vehicles increased by 30% with 236 incidents, compared to 181 over the same period in 2024. One hundred and thirty-three vehicles were recovered.













## Charged - District





### 61% Persons Charged




## Court Case Disposition
